News from Grade 1L

It has been a busy 3 weeks of learning and discovery. We settled back into school after the longest school holiday and got straight into Book Week. A spectacular week of reading books, collecting 'caught reading cards,' purchasing books, and eventually getting dressed in our favourite book character costume. Our class read a book titled, 'More' and loved it! It's a narrative text with a twist, similar to a story we had studied earlier in the year titled, 'Where the Wild Things Are.'

In English, we revisited what we expect to see happen during our literacy stations. We identified that to be good learners we need to: use appropriate voice levels; move to our spot; collect our things; start with our work. In phonics, we identified high frequency words and recognised patterns in words. In reading, we realised being passionate about something and reading lots can make us specialists in that particular subject area. Currently in writing, we are following the cinquain poem rule to create some awesome poems about the weather.

At the moment in Maths, we are working on the bridging through 10 strategy when adding and subtracting numbers. In inquiry, we're exploring the weather, identifying various instruments used to record wind direction, speed, rain fall etc. Our class identified the four types of clouds and created windmills to act as weather vanes when observing wind direction. We are also keeping a class weather log, to keep a record of the daily weather.
