As we come to the end of the first full week, teachers are well on their way to completing our baseline assessments in reading and mathematics for the year.

As always, this will support us to meet each child's individual needs and ensure they are in appropriate groups across their classes. These groups are flexible and take into account the different progress children make in different areas. This year, they will involve students working across their double classroom space and with teachers across their level.

On Tuesday, students brought home their "Learning In...". These documents share the main ideas which are covered in each subject area for each classroom. The IEA curriculum is written in levels. Level 1 has a single grade level - Prep, with the other Levels all stretching over two grades. TEMIS ensures that the curriculum is covered in depth by working on a two year cycle. This has operated since 2009 and this systems lends itself well to the new structure.

We look forward to welcoming you to our Parent Information Evening next Tuesday – you should have received a letter regarding this earlier in the week. It will be an opportunity to hear about routines and expectations in each level. If you need to talk about your child's learning individually, please arrange a convenient time.

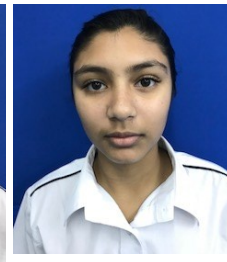
